

Start of School Suggestions

1. Attend Meet the Teacher Night at your child's school for specific route information or visit www.transfinder.com. You will also receive a bus rider post card with bus stop and route specifics on or about July 7, 2008.
2. Make sure your child knows his/her name and address. If not write the information in their backpack.
3. Familiarize your child with his/her bus stop before the first day of school.
4. Make sure your child recognizes his/her route number.

For Parents

- Review safety tips with your child regularly.
- Team with other parents to get involved and monitor bus stops. Voice concerns to Transportation immediately.
- Get to know your district Transportation Coordinator and your child's bus driver. These are trained professionals who see your child every day.

Transportation Frequently Asked Questions

When should my child arrive at the morning bus stop?

Students are asked to be at their stop at least five (5) minutes before the scheduled pick-up time.

What if my child's bus is late: am or pm?

Due to unforeseen circumstances, buses may be late on occasion. If this should occur please call our office at 520-868-8800 for information

Can I ride the bus with my child?

No, parents may not ride the bus to and/or from school. Parents may only ride the bus on field trips.

How do you determine the placement of bus stops?

Bus stops are assigned based on general location of students. Typical stop locations are in subdivisions near parks, common walls, or retentions areas. DPS (Department of Public Safety) requires us to follow bus stop placement safety guidelines.

How do I find my child's bus stop information?

All bus stop information will be available at each school site as well as at the Transportation office after July 7, 2008. Transportation route information will also be available at your child's open house. If your child is pre-enrolled for the 2008-2009 school year and is eligible for transportation you will receive a bus rider post card with route and stop specifics on or about July 7, 2008.

Can my child ride home on a different bus?

Because there is limited space, only eligible students may ride their assigned bus. Any request for exceptions must be made by a parent to transportation or the school administrator. The bus driver must be notified in writing on a bus pass from the school office.

What if my child left a belonging on the bus?

Are there seat assignments on the bus?
